5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Federal Government, and 6 any State or local government or health care provider that 7 receives Federal financial assistance under this Act (or 8 under an amendment made by this Act) or any health plan O:\KER\KER09578.xml

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created under this Act (or under an amendment made by
 this Act), may not subject an individual or institutional
 health care entity to discrimination on the basis that the
 entity does not provide any health care item or service fur nished for the purpose of causing, or for the purpose of
 assisting in causing, the death of any individual, such as
 by assisted suicide, euthanasia, or mercy killing.

8 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term "health 9 care entity" includes an individual physician or other 10 health care professional, a hospital, a provider-sponsored 11 organization, a health maintenance organization, a health 12 insurance plan, or any other kind of health care facility, 13 organization, or plan.

(c) CONSTRUCTION AND TREATMENT OF CERTAIN
SERVICES.—Nothing in subsection (a) shall be construed
to apply to or to affect any limitation relating to—

17 (1) the withholding or withdrawing of medical18 treatment or medical care;

19 (2) the withholding or withdrawing of nutrition20 or hydration;

21 (3) abortion; or

(4) the use of an item, good, benefit, or service
furnished for the purpose of alleviating pain or discomfort, even if such use may increase the risk of
death, so long as such item, good, benefit, or service

is not also furnished for the purpose of causing, or
 the purpose of assisting in causing, death, for any
 reason.

4 (d) ADMINISTRATION.—The Office for Civil Rights of
5 the Department of Health and Human Services is des6 ignated to receive complaints of discrimination based on
7 this section.
